

## Cage-Free Daycare / Overnight Requirements + What to Bring

### Vaccination Requirements

You are responsible for sharing immunization records with House of Woof. You can submit all vaccine records to [houseofwoof@shots.pet](mailto:houseofwoof@shots.pet) or bring in during your next visit

Rabies	Must be current
Bordetella	Updated <u>within last 6 months</u>
DA2PP, DHLPP, Parvo	Must be current
Canine Influenza	Consult with your Vet
Flea Protection	Must be on preventative treatment
Fecal Test	Consult with your Vet

### Other Requirements

- Your dog must be at least 14 weeks old and have completed their entire set of puppy vaccinations before they can participate in our services
- All dogs must be spayed/neutered by 7 months (or before first heat)
- Parents must complete the Parent and Pet Application found on our [website](#)
- All dogs must complete and pass a free 4-hour cage-free evaluation
- All dogs attending daycare must be in good health. For dog's older than 10+ years or with medical conditions (e.g., ligament tears, hip injuries, seizures), a vet must complete a [Senior / Medical Release Waiver](#) that is shared with House of Woof
